Flag Day - June 14th



In 1775, the Continental Congress named a committee to propose a design for a national flag. On this day in 1777 in Philadelphia, PA, John Adams introduced the following resolution to the Continental Congress: "Resolved, That the flag of the thirteen United States shall be thirteen stripes, alternate red and white; that the union be thirteen stars, white on a blue field, representing a new constellation." This resolution was passed adopting the Stars and Stripes as the official flag of the United States. George Washington later said, "We take the stars from Heaven, the red from our mother country, separating it by white stripes thus showing that we have separated from her, and the white stripes shall go down to posterity representing Liberty." The five-pointed star may have been chosen instead of the six-pointed star of Britain for its similarity to one used by France, our only ally at that time.

As states were added to the Union over the years, the revised flag was unveiled on the 4th of July of the following years. In 1877, on the 100th anniversary of the adoption of the original design of the flag, Congress declared that the nation's flags be flown over public buildings on June 14th. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed that Flag Day should be celebrated every year on June 14th, but it wasn't until August 1949 that an Act of Congress was signed by President Harry Truman designating June 14th as National Flag Day!
